Rule Regarding Sanitary Requirements-Animals

Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Directors:

Sanitary Requirements-Animals: Any person owning, possessing, harboring or having the care, charge, control or custody of any animal shall immediately remove and thereafter dispose of any fecal matter deposited by the animal on common or private property. The fecal matter shall be immediately placed in a closed or sealed container and thereafter disposed of by depositing said matter in a trash receptacle that is closed or sealed in an approved manner free of health hazard or public health nuisance. At no time will animal fecal matter be allowed accumulate or to interfere with the health, comfort, safety and general welfare of the residents. This section shall not apply to blind persons accompanied by an animal used for assistance or for service animals.
